Salmones Camanchaca Fish Feed Sustainability Statement

Salmones Camanchaca has a commitment with the sustainable development of salmon farming, and it has decided to advance its sustainability agenda in a constant, proactive and progressive manner, effectively addressing the social and environmental risks in its supply chain.

Salmones Camanchaca expects its suppliers to adopt standards, set targets and implement initiatives that contribute demonstrably to minimize their social and environmental risks. Fish feed production is a significant component of salmon farming's social and environmental footprint, due to the diversity of raw materials and supply chains involved in its manufacturing.

In this context, Salmones Camanchaca commits to work with its feed suppliers to implement and achieve the following initiatives and targets:

- All fish feed supplied to Salmones Camanchaca must be produced with raw materials that
 have not contributed to the deforestation of native forests in any part of the world. This
 must be demonstrated by credible certifications. All fish feed used by Salmones
 Camanchaca must be certified to be Deforestation and Conversion Free at a maximum –
 by 2025.
- 2. Fish feed companies supplying to Salmones Camanchaca must have greenhouse gas emission reduction targets set according to the Science Based Targets Initiative by year end 2023.
- 3. Energy use in feed plants and mills where fish feed is produced must be 100% renewable by 2030.
- Fish feed companies supplying to Salmones Camanchaca are required to have a robust and reliable Life Cycle Analysis that allows the optimization of diets to minimize specific impact categories by 2025.
