- Identify the conclusions, limitations and recommendations associated with the process.


Conclusions

- All the inconsistencies found were clarified and improved, therefore, no aspect has been revealed that makes us believe that the information provided about the Dow Jones Sustainability Index (DJSI) Supply Chain Management Indicators contains significant errors.
