

Salmones Camanchaca Fish Feed Sustainability Policy

Our company recognizes that the production of feed for our salmon is a significant component of our social and environmental footprint. It is essential to address the associated risks diligently and effectively while also seizing opportunities that can create business value. This Sustainable Feed Policy outlines our commitment to sustainability and the expectations we have for our feed suppliers.

Salmones Camanchaca expects its suppliers to adopt standards, set targets and implement initiatives that contribute demonstrably to minimize their social and environmental risks. In this context, Salmones Camanchaca commits to work with its feed suppliers to implement and achieve the following requirements.

Requirements for Feed Suppliers

General Requirements

Feed suppliers participating in our tender process must complete the "Sustainability Tender SC" and "SBT Tender SC" forms. Suppliers must also address the additional requirements specified in this section.

Within the topics included in the sustainability assessment:

- Transparency, management system, governance, human rights, restorative land use and biodiversity practices, sustainable fishing, carbon footprint, circularity, pollution, water consumption, nutrition, and climate change impacts

The sufficiency and robustness of the provided information will be considered in the decision to award feed volumes.

Information to be Provided by Suppliers

Suppliers must include the following information in an annex to their proposal:

1. Corporate Sustainability Strategy

- Provide a detailed description of the corporate sustainability strategy, including the materiality analysis that supports it.

2. Environmental Policy and Goals

- Outline the company's environmental policy and any associated waste management goals.

3. Supplier Policy

- Describe the social and environmental standards applied to suppliers of marine and terrestrial raw materials. For terrestrial raw materials, indicate the certifications and/or measures adopted to prevent ecosystem degradation and biodiversity loss.

4. Traceability System

- Explain the traceability system for raw materials and the programs in place to verify the absence of contaminants. Include a list of contaminants that are reviewed.

5. Greenhouse Gas Emission Reduction Goals

- Detail the current goals and strategies to reduce greenhouse gas emissions across Scope 1, 2, and 3.

6. Certification of Fish Meal and Fish Oil

- Report the percentage of fish meal and fish oil certified by Marine Trust, MSC, and those not certified, separately for each quarter of the years 2022, 2023, and Q1 2024.

7. Good Management of Pesticides and Fertilizers: Suppliers must demonstrate adherence to best practices for pesticide and fertilizer use to minimize environmental impact, including measures to prevent contamination and promote sustainable agriculture. Detailed breakdown of how pesticide and fertilizer management practices are integrated into the feed production process, including any additional costs associated with implementing sustainable practices

Quarterly Reporting

At the end of each quarter, alongside the "Retroactive" submission, suppliers must indicate the percentage of the following for the total volume of feed consumed by our company:

1. Soy and its derivatives certified 100% deforestation and conversion-free.
2. Certified fish meal (MSC and Marine Trust).
3. Certified fish oil (MSC and Marine Trust).

Quotation of Diets with Sustainability Requirements

For each line of diets offered, suppliers must provide quarterly quotes for the following attributes separately:

1. 100% Deforestation and Conversion-Free Soy
 - Use of soy that is 100% deforestation and conversion-free.
2. 100% Certified Marine Ingredients
 - Use of marine ingredients that are 100% certified by MSC or Marine Trust.
3. Formulation for Decarbonization Trajectories
 - Formulation that enables our company to achieve the decarbonization trajectories required by the Science Based Targets for Scope 3 associated with feed, as described in the "SBT Tender SC" document.

Pricing Structure

Suppliers must indicate the percentage of the additional price for each of these requirements that corresponds to the cost element and the plus element in the price structure. These prices should be included as a new section at the end of the Cost-Plus quotations.

This Sustainable Feed Policy underscores our commitment to reducing the environmental and social impact of our operations. We expect our feed suppliers to align with these sustainability requirements, thereby contributing to a more sustainable and responsible salmon aquaculture industry.
